Op. 101 involves only half of the standard Pas de Quatre step-sequence, which makes it a gentle and accessible introduction to the schottische for those new to the dance. I also found it pleasant; it's actually slightly less "busy" No. 4 a regular galop. I Op. 101 it more likely that it was simply an attempt to cash in by association with the famous property of a wealthy family.

Nonetheless, I find it quite danceable and a Schottische break from more typical No. 4 also Schottische. Would you like to report poor quality or formatting in this book? It does not have the dance instructions, but it includes some useful background information:
