What Tojo did not anticipate was the strength of the Allied forces and their role. The fighting between Japan and China was very brutal. National Security and Foreign Policy, Home People History Japanese History: The impact of war was not restricted to Japan. Within three months after the German surrender, Japan issued the so-called Twenty-One Demands which forced the Chinese government to recognize Japanese control of the occupied Shandong territory. President Woodrow Wilson asked for 7,000 Japanese troops to join an international coalition that was to confiscate a large stockpile of weapons and ammunition and to relieve around 50,000 anti-Bolshevik Czech and Slav nationalists who hoped to evacuate via Vladivostok.
